| Paper | No of Pieces | Metric Measurement |

| Copper Clay Card Base | 1 | 10.5cm x 29.7cm |
| Copper Clay Cardstock Layers | 3 | 10.3cm x 14.3cm |
| Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper (Gray Granite) Layers | 3 | 10.1cm x 14.1cm |
| Basic White Cardstock for Mechanism | 1 | 19cm x 16cm Score on the long side at 7cm, 9cm, 11cm and 18cm |
| | | On the short side score at 1cm (down to first fold) and then cut at 2cm, continue going along the whole piece until you have seven strips. With the remaining piece do not score - just ensure this piece is cut to 2cm! |
| Pecan Pie Belly Band Trusty Toolbox Designer Paper for Belly Band | ן ז | 4cm x 29.7cm 3.8cm x roughly 10.5cm (this will change and need to be cut down depending on final size of belly band) |
| Trusty Toolbox Designer Paper for Inside of Card | 1 | 2.5cm x 10.1cm |
| Lustre Specialty Paper in Copper Clay | 1 | .5cm x 10.1cm |
| Scraps of Copper Clay for Stamping | | Scrap for stamping sentiment and some embellishments |

Instructions

- Cut the card base from Copper Clay Cardstock. Score at each end at 14.5cm, this will form a 'spine'. Set aside.
- 2. Take each of the three layers of Copper Clay Cardstock and adhere the layers of Gray Granite Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper to each. Spritz each of these pieces with a Copper Clay Stampin' Write Marker. Add one of these layers to the front of the card and one to each side inside of the card.



- 3. Score and cut the mechanism as stated in the cut/score guide above using a piece of Basic White which has been coloured using a Blending Brush and some Crumb Cake Ink. Take all eight of the little mechanism pieces and fold into a 'W' fold, using the little tab piece to adhere together ensuring the tab is adhered towards the inside. Use the score line to help with adhering these mechanism pieces together. Add glue to the left hand side of the score line to the first piece and adhere the next mechanism piece to the top (only where glue is added). Repeat this step until all pieces are adhered, finishing with the mechanism that has no score line. For this step it is easiest to watch the video (linked below).
- 4. Adhere the mechanism to the middle of the card, lining up with the edge of the Designer Series Paper and centred with the middle of the card. Only add adhesive to the very right hand side mechanism and once this is adhered add adhesive to the very left hand side mechanism which will be adhered to the top side of the card. See video. Allow to dry.
- 5. Fussy cut out as many tools from the Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper as you will require. Start adhering these to the 'tabs' on the mechanism where you desire, ensuring they will not be seen when the card is closed. I have used liquid adhesive to add my tools.
- 6. Add the 2.5cm x 10.1cm strip of Trusty Toolbox Designer Paper to the bottom edge of the inside of the card and then add the tiny strip of Copper Clay Lustre Specialty Paper above this.
- 7. To make the belly band, take the strip of Copper Clay cardstock and lay the card on the middle of this piece, make a mark about .5cm on either side of the card and then place the strip in a paper trimmer, scoring on this line, move along the trimmer and make another score about .5cm

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further along, this will form a belly band with a spine. Adhere this together with Liquid Glue. Take the strip of Trusty Toolbox Designer Series Paper which may need to be trimmed down depending on the size of the belly band. Distress the top right hand side with a bone folder, rolling the corner back and forth. Adhere to the belly band, adding a staple if desired.

- 8. Using some of the left over fussy cut toolbox images, adhere some to the front of the belly band with Liquid Glue.
- 9. Take the scrap piece of Copper Clay Cardstock and the He's All That Stamp Set heat emboss in white using Versamark Ink the "To The Man Who Does Everything","Love This Guy" and finally the "No. 1" images. Trim out the first sentiment and add to the belly band with liquid glue. Add the second two images to the inside of the card to the bottom of the card and to the mechanism.
- 10. Embellish the card with some of the copper Brushed Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots.
