



#### Measurements

Basic White Thick Card Base	1	10.5cm x 29.7cm (scored at 14.9cm)
Sweet Sorbet Cardstock Layers for Front of the Card	1	9.8cm x 14.2cm 9.6 x 14cm
Basic White Thick Cardstock Layer for Inside of The Card	1	14.1cm x 9.7cm
Sweet Sorbet Cardstock Layer for Inside of The Card	1	14.3cm x 9.9cm
Strip of Sweet Sorbet In Colour Textured Specialty Paper for Inside of Card	1	2cm x 9.7cm
Small Strip of More Dazzle Specialty Paper for Inside of Card	1	.5cm x 9.7cm
Scrap Pieces of Basic White Thick, Basic Black and Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock for Die Cutting and Stamping		

## Instructions

- 1. Cut the card base and all the layers listed above.
- 2. Take the smallest layer of Sweet Sorbet for the front of the card and use the Whisper White Craft Ink to add ink to the Rays of Light background stamp. I have added my background stamp to my glass mat and then added my cardstock layer laid over the top of the inked stamp. I have then used the Stampin' Brayer to help roll and add pressure over the top allowing for a nice evenly



stamped image. Once this is done, add some White Craft Ink to an acrylic block and lightly add some water to water down, using a paintbrush, spritz some of the White Craft Ink over the background and allow to dry. Set aside.

- 3. Stamp a variety of different watermelon images from the Watercolor Melon Stamp Set on Basic White Thick Cardstock. I have used a mixture of Sweet Sorbet for the 'flesh' and Granny Apple Green for the rind with some Memento Black for the seeds. For the large watermelon I have used Granny Apple Green and Garden Green (which I added lightly with a Blending Brush to add highlights). I have also stamped some of the leaves with Shaded Spruce. Fussy cut all these images out and set aside.
- 4. Die cut out the second largest circle from the Everyday Details Dies from Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock and take some Granny Apple Green Ink, using a Blending Brush to lightly colour around the edge. Using some Parakeet Party Baker's Twine and a needle, backstitch around the edge to add some texture and detail. Set aside.
- 5. Now that the first stamped Rays of Light piece has dried. Adhere it down to the larger Sweet Sorbet layer and adhere to the card base.
- 6. Take the Lemon Lime Twist Circle and adhere to the left hand side of the card where shown with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Next adhere all the fussy cut melon pieces, alternating between adhering with Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals. I added the largest melon with dimensionals, the middle layer with Liquid Glue and then the final melon with Dimensionals. Adhere all the leaves where shown with Liquid Glue.

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- 8. Take one of the Paper Butterflies and add a sheen of the Wink of Stella painted over the top, add some Liquid Glue and adhere where shown.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment from the Heartfelt Hellos stamp set on a scrap of Basic Black Cardstock in Versamark and heat emboss in white. Trim this sentiment out and adhere to the card where shown with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 10. Embellish the card with some Iridescent Rhinestones and spritz with some Wink of Stella.
- 11. To embellish the inside of the card take the layer of Basic White Thick Cardstock and add some light blending with a blending brush on the right hand side with some Granny Apple Green Ink. Spritz over the top with a Sweet Sorbet Stampin' Write Marker. Down the bottom adhere the strip of Sweet Sorbet Specialty Paper and More Dazzle Specialty Paper. Adhere the fussy cut watermelon and leaf. Add this piece to the larger layer of Sweet Sorbet and adhere to the inside of the card.
