


Instructions

- Cut all the layers of cardstock and Designer Series Paper as listed above. Set aside.
- 2. Take the layer of Crumb Cake Cardstock intended for the Inner Pop Up Flower Box Layer and use the template on the last page, cut and score as shown. Use the video attached if you need further guidance. Ensure that you burnish the scores with a bone folder well.
- Take a Blending Brush and some Crumb Cake Ink and lightly blend some ink around the edges of this piece. Spritz



some ink from a Pecan Pie Stampin' Write Marker on the bottom right hand corner and top left hand corner of this piece.

4. Take the two pieces of Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper intended for the Flower Box and trim if needed. Use a Sponge Dauber to add some Crumb Cake Ink to the edges for some light distressing before adding to the front of the flower box. For the "front flaps" of the flower box, take the pieces of Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper and on the long edge score using the measurement as noted above. Place the two flaps together and use scissors to cut each side on an angle.



- 5. Add a little bit of Shaded Spruce to the edges of the flaps with a Sponge Dauber and then add adhesive to one side of the score as shown above on the reverse side that will adhere to the flower box. Adhere down.
- 6. Now it is time to stamp. You will need to take the Painted Lavender Stamp Set and stamp two sets of stems from the stamp set, both the larger stem in Shaded Spruce and the singular stem in Lost Lagoon. You will also need to stamp two sets of the butterflies in Berry Burst as well as one big bunch of lavender and four small lavender stems. I have pictured what you will need to stamp below.



The lavender bunch is stamped in a mixture of Gorgeous Grape and Fresh Freesia Inks and the lavender stem is stamped in a mixture of Fresh Freesia, Highland Heather, Gorgeous Grape and Berry Burst. See the video for tips.

Die cut all of these stamped images out with the corresponding dies.

- 7. Using the Painted Lavender Dies, die cut out five of the large leafy dies in Shaded Spruce and add some extra definition to these with some Shaded Spruce Ink and a Sponge Dauber. Die cut out some of the smaller foliage dies with some Berry Burst Soft Shimmer Specialty Paper and then die cut out the large leafy stems with some Fluid 100 Watercolour Paper. Set aside.
- 8. Using a Water Painter add water to the entire large leafy stem die cut. Using some Gorgeous Grape Ink, add some colour to the bottom half of the flowers only. Repeat and add some Berry Burst Ink with the Water Painter to the top half of the flowers on blending over the Gorgeous Grape sections. Add Lost Lagoon to the remaining part and stems. Allow to dry and then add Wink of Stella over the whole stem. Set aside.
- 9. Start arranging all the pieces in the flower box. You can use as many or as little pieces as you like in your little flower box, just make sure that your card will shut. I like to test it as I go and make sure nothing catches! I have used Glue Dots to adhere all my pieces. For reference I used three singular lavender pieces, three die cut Shaded Spruce foliage pieces, three Berry Burst die cut foliage pieces and three watercoloured foliage pieces as well as three butterflies. I also adhered one Paper Butterfly with Glue Dots!

- 10. Once this is all adhered the inside is almost done. Simply stamp a sentiment in the bottom right hand corner and your inside is finished!
- 11. This card benefits having a ribbon closure due to being bulky. Adhere the two pieces of Designer Series Paper to the two layers of Crumb Cake Cardstock. Before adhering to the front of the card I have frayed a length of the Lost Lagoon Ribbon (approximately 12" or 30cm) to create some loose threads and wrapped this around my fingers 2-3 times before stapling this to my card front. See the video for tips for how I did this.
- 12. Cut a length of ribbon to 60cm or 24" and wrap around the card centre using Tear N' Tape to hold it in place. Adhere the two layers of card over the top with adhesive. Tie the ribbon in a bow.
- 13. Adhere the stems to the bottom of the leftover singular lavender and lavender bunch and adhere two of the Shaded Spruce foliage pieces to the card front. Create a bunch of lavender pieces on the card as you like, adhering the two stamped lavender pieces on Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 14. Stamp the sentiment on a scrap of Basic White in Berry Burst and trim and adhere to the card on Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 15. Add some light blending using a Sponge Dauber to one of the Paper Butterfly Accents and some Wink of Stella before adhering to the card where shown.
- 16. Embellish with some of the Purple Fine Shimmer Gems.
