Instructions

- 1. Cut all the layers of cardstock and Designer Series Paper as listed above.
- 2. Take the layers of Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock for the inside and outside layers and also the pieces of Flowering Zinnia designer series paper you will use for the inside and outside of the card. With a Blending Brush and some Melon Mambo Ink, lightly blend some ink around the edges of the designer paper. Using a Melon Mambo Stampin' Write Marker spritz some ink over these pieces. Adhere these pieces to the Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock. Adhere one of these to the inside of the card.
- 3. Now to create the mechanism that will create the pop up slider for the card, take the two pieces of Lemon Lime Twist cut in the cutting guide above. You will need to score them as in the guideline listed. Once this is all cut and scored. Add adhesive to the panels as shown in the photo guide below. For this part of the instruction it is easiest to watch the assembly of the mechanism with the video linked on the last page.

- 4. Once the pop up mechanism is all in place. I have worked on and decorated my pop up. To do this I have cut a rectangle as a 'placeholder' for my decoration. I used the Perennial Postage Dies to cut the fourth largest rectangle twice, once in the Berry Burst specialty Glimmer paper and once in Real Red Cardstock. From the Real Red Cardstock lightly mist with water from a Stampin' Spritzer and run through a die cut machine with the Zinnia 3D embossing folder. I added some detail to this by going around the edges with a Blending Brush and some Melon Mambo Ink. Cut the postage edges off the Real Red die to get a straight rectangle and adhere this to the Berry Burst rectangle with Tear N' Tape. Set aside.
- 5. For my decoration, I cut three small Zinnias to piece together in; Melon Mambo, Pumpkin Pie and Flirty Flamingo and I have also cut the Stems in Old Olive. Before piecing these together, add some sponged detail to these using a Sponge Dauber and the same coloured ink. I have also stamped the single Zinnia image from the stamp set in Memento Tuxedo Black Ink and die cut this out. Add some Wink of Stella to these images. I have chosen to fussy cut out a few flower images from the Flowering Zinnias Designer Series Paper on the design that features singular Zinnias.
- 6. Using the rectangle cut in step four, use this as a base to adhere all the Zinnias. I have placed them all and decided where I wanted them to go first so that I could see a glimpse of the glimmer from the rectangle and a little bit of the design poking through. Once you are happy it is good to check that the design will not impede shutting the card both at the top and be seen when the card closes at the bottom. Carefully adhere all the images with Glue Dots or Liquid Adhesive. I have used staples where they will not be seen.
- 7. Using the sentiment "Thank You So Much", heat embossed this on Basic Black cardstock in white. Trim this down and cut the ends on an angle. Using a scrap of More Dazzle Cardstock cut a strip roughly 1cm wide and slightly longer than your sentiment strip to add as an accent to your sentiment. Cut the strip on an angle. Use Tear N' Tape to adhere the two pieces together. Adhere this piece to the card with Tear N' Tape.
- 8. Now it's time to adhere the whole pop up piece. Take the Tear N' Tape strip off and carefully place the rectangle piece over the top and check when the card closes it is fine on both the top with no catching and no pieces poke out the bottom. Once happy press down on the Tear N' Tape.
- 9. Embellish the pop up slider piece with the Shiny Sequins both on the pop up slider piece piece and directly on the Melon Mambo card piece.
- 10. Take the Basic White Writing Panel card piece and lightly add some Lemon Lime Twist ink to the bottom right hand side with a Blending Brush. Using the singular Zinnia stamp from the stamp set and some Versamark Ink add some shadow stamping to the right hand side of this

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piece for a subtle look. Adhere this piece to the layer of Lemon Lime Twist and adhere where shown to the inside top panel of the card.

- 11. Fussy cut some more Zinnia flowers from the same designer paper used for the inside of the card. Set aside. Stamp two Zinnia singular images and cut these out, add Wink of Stella to Zinnias. Die cut out the Zinnias again from Pumpkin Pie, Flirty Flamingo and Melon Mambo with the Stems in Old Olive, and blend as done in step five. Stamp the sentiment "Words Fail to Express My Gratitude" in Versamark and heat emboss in white on Basic Black, trim and cut the ends on an angle. Repeat the same technique with the More Dazzle Specialty Paper. Now all these pieces are cut. Arrange them all on the front of the card piece set aside in step two. Once happy with where all the flowers and embellishments go, adhere all these down. Do not adhere the sentiment.
- 12. Cut a length of Wavy Trim approximately 15cm long and pull apart the threads on either end, using a Take Your Pick can help with this technique. I have used my sentiment to work out approximately where my trim will go and used a staple to hold in place. Adhere the sentiment over the top with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 13. Spritz the card with Wink of Stella and embellish with Shiny Sequins.
