


Shopping is Always a Good Idea

Measurements

Instructions

- 1. Cut all the layers needed that are listed in the measurement guide.
- 2. Take your card base and score in half. Adhere the layer of Designer Paper on both the front of the card and on both panels of the inside. Using the Deckled Circles Dies and some post it notes (or tape) to hold in place, position the two dies on the front of the card together with the smaller die placed in the middle. I have used the 3rd, 5th and 8th die in the set measured from the smallest circle onwards. If you don't have these dies you just need to find circles with these similar sizes (3 1/2", 2 7/8" & 1 3/4" OR 9cm, 7.5cm & 4.5cm) Run this card front through your Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and keep all the pieces.
- 3. Cut the mechanism and score and cut away as stated in both the measurement guide and the template below. See the video for tips on how to put this mechanism together. You want to make sure the mechanism is scored well. When cutting off all of the pieces, discard all the pieces **except one** of the large rectangle pieces, this will be used in the mechanism. Fold over these large rectangle flaps on the mechanism and glue them down to the middle.



X - cut away these sections (including the entire grey section)
score these lines diagonally once X sections have been cut
score lines - refer to measurement guide for measurements

4. Fold the mechanism out flat with the side with the 'arms' furthest away from the centrefold. Place the tab so it is in the middle of the card on the score line on the right hand side of the inside of the card. Add glue to the tab and fold the card flat.

- 5. Make sure your large die cut circle from the card front is the direction you want it in (if it has a directional pattern) and feed the mechanism through this donut mechanism piece so that it comes out the centre. Use some post it note on the front of the card to hold the die cut circle piece in the direction you choose. Fold the mechanism back together and place a bit of adhesive only on the left hand side "arm". Adhere this to the die cut circle. Add a little bit of adhesive to the top side of the other arm and use the rectangle piece that was leftover when cutting the mechanism, adhere this to this piece vertically to create a "tab" for the little circle to sit. Take the small die cut circle from the front of the card and add some adhesive to the underside of the 'arm' piece and adhere this small circle making sure to place it away from the centrefold and the top of the card. Add a little bit of liquid glue now on the actual mechanism on the tab piece (underneath what should be a triangle) and close the card shut. Place something heavy on the card and give this whole mechanism time to dry. I recommend watching the video for how to put the mechanism together and you can watch between 27:00m and 42:00m just to see this part of the card.
- 6. Die cut an additional circle using the Deckled Circles Dies from Fresh Freesia Cardstock. Use the 5th die from the smallest to cut this out. Using a Blending Brush add some Berry Burst ink around the edges. Use a Berry Burst Stampin' Write Marker to spritz some ink on this piece.
- 7. On a scrap piece of Basic White Thick cardstock stamp the shopping bag image from the Attention Shoppers Bundle seven times in Memento Black Ink. Colour these images in a variety of Stampin' Blends. Die cut these out with the corresponding die from the bundle.
- 8. Using the Attention Shoppers Dies die cut the base of the shopping trolley in some Silver Foil. Die cut the actual trolley only die cutting the handle with Silver Foil. Take some Berry Burst Cardstock and add some Adhesive Sheet to the cardstock. Die cut a shopping trolley from this piece. Cut the handle of the trolley and adhere to the Berry Burst trolley. Remove the adhesive sheet and place three shopping bags in the trolley adhering over the top. Add a glue dot or adhesive to the base and adhere to the trolley.
- 9. Add some Silver Trim crossed over in a faux bow to the Fresh Freesia Deckled circle, being sure not to make it too wide as it needs to be no wider than the card "window". Adhere the shopping trolley over the top with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 10. Stamp the two sentiments in Versamark on Basic Black cardstock and heat emboss in white. Fussy cut both of these images and adhere one of them to the Fresh Freesia Circle with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 11. Embellish the circle with some Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems.

- 12. Take the card and add liquid adhesive to the front of the mechanism only where the triangle and end of the mechanism is and about 2.5cm or 1" further back. Adhere the Fresh Freesia circle on top of this. You should now be able to open the card and see the mechanism and how it works.
- 13. Using Glue Dots attach the remaining shopping bags and sentiment to the mechanism as shown, being sure to check with each one that as the mechanism opens and shuts that they won't be able to be seen when the card is closed. See the video for tips. For adding the sentiment add a little bit of adhesive on the back on the right hand side and add a little bit of adhesive to the bottom of the 'Y' on the left hand side to hold this in place.
- 14. Spritz the card with some Wink of Stella.
- 15. To create a space to write on the back of the card, take the piece of Basic White and add some Berry Burst ink blending in the right hand corner. Stamp a shopping bag in Berry Burst ink and add some Wink of Stella to this image. Spritz the cardstock with some ink from a Berry Burst Stampin' Write Marker and adhere this to a layer of Fresh Freesia. Adhere to the back of the card.
