



Measurements

Instructions

- 1. Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide.
- 2. Take the layer of Fluid 100 Watercolour Paper and using baby wipes and the ink refills start with Berry Burst by squeezing 1-2 drops on a baby wipe and using this to add the colour directly to the Fluid 100 Watercolour piece. Work your way in sections downwards using; Calypso Coral, Pumpkin Pie and then finally Daffodil Delight. Make sure to blend a bit of the colour as you work your way down.
- 3. To the same piece, add some stamping using one of the large foliage stamps from the Thoughtful Wishes stamp set, stamping in Versamark Ink for a subtle background effect. Add some light stamping using the 'splatter' stamp in the coordinating ink colour to each section. Spritz the background with a Calypso Coral Stampin' Write Marker. Let this piece dry and then add to a layer of Basic White Thick Cardstock. Adhere this to the Berry Burst card base.
- 4. Using the Thoughtful Moments Hybrid Embossing Folder, ink the fold on the SU logo side with Memento Black ink liberally. Add a large 6"x 6" or (15cm x 15cm) scrap of Basic White Thick Cardstock into the folder with the coordinating die in place and cut all the sentiments out. Using the "Hello" die cut sentiment add some Peach Pie and Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends Markers to colour the middle sections of the word. Set aside.
- 5. Take a scrap piece of Basic White Thick Cardstock and use the two colours of Stampin' Blends to scribble and colour on a section of the cardstock blending them in between large enough to cut out four leaves from the Thoughtful Wishes Dies. Die cut these out and set aside.
- 6. Stamp the large leaf foliage stamp from the Thoughtful Wishes Stamp Set in Versamark and heat emboss in gold. Using a Water Painter and some Berry Burst and Calypso Coral Ink, colour in each individual leaf starting with Blackberry Bliss at the base and blend in between. Die cut this piece out with the corresponding die. Set this aside and also cut out a large foliage piece with the die from the Gold Glimmer Specialty Paper.
- 7. Adhere all these pieces to the card where shown with Glue Dots or Liquid Glue. Before adhering the sentiment, tie a bow with Linen Thread and fold the loops over before adhering to the card with a Glue Dot. Adhere the sentiment over the top with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. Spritz the card with Wink of Stella and embellish with some of the Pearls.
- 9. To decorate the inside of the card, take the smaller layer of Basic White Thick cardstock and add some Daffodil Delight, Pumpkin Pie and Calypso Coral soft blending using a Blending Brush in the bottom right hand corner. Use some Berry Burst Ink to stamp the large leaf/foliage image

over the top of the blending. Use some Calypso Coral Ink to stamp some 'splatter' images in the bottom right and then spritz this inside piece with a Calypso Coral Stampin' Write Marker. Adhere this layer to another layer of Basic White and then add to the inside of the card.
