

#### Measurements

Paper	No of Pieces	Metric Measurement
Basic Beige Card Base	1	16cm x 29cm Score at 12cm and 24cm
Basic Beige for Mechanism	2 2	7cm x 11.5cm (score at 1.5cm and 10cm) 7cm x 10cm (score at 1.5cm)
Country Woods Designer Paper for Mechanism	2	6.8cm x 8.3cm
Country Woods Designer Paper for Card Front & Inside	2	11.8cm x 15.8cm 7.5cm x 15.8cm
Country Woods Designer Paper for inside flap	1	4.8cm x 15.8cm
Summer Splash Cardstock for Card Front	1	9.5cm x 13cm
Scraps Of Basic Beige, Basic White Thick, Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock and Summer Splash Glimmer Paper for Stamping and Die Cutting		

## Instructions

- 1. Cut all the cardstock layers and pieces needed as stated in the measurement guide.
- 2. Score the card base as stated in the measurement guide and fold in half, while folding the smaller 'flap' inwards so it sits inside the card.
- 3. Using the Country Woods Designer Paper for the inside and card front, take one of the larger layers and adhere to the inside left of the card and the smaller piece to the right hand side. Adhere the leftover piece to the card front.
- 4. Using a tiny strip of glue on both sides of the inside flap, fold this over and adhere to the inside of the card to create a pocket.
- 5. Score and fold the mechanism pieces as stated in the measurement guide. The larger piece that is scored on both sides is placed on the bottom. Add adhesive to the scored section on the smaller layer of Basic Beige and adhere to the scored section on the right hand side of the larger piece. This will create a 'book fold' that opens the wrong way. Once you have done this to both pieces of the mechanism, place these in the pocket so that the left hand side of the mechanism (while folded flat) sits just beside the cards centre score line. Add liquid glue to the scored section on the left hand side of each of these pieces. Fold the card closed to adhere. See the video for tips and to see how I made the mechanism.
- 6. Add the two pieces of designer paper cut for the mechanism to the front of each fold out flap, adhering with liquid glue. Add the Country Woods Designer Paper cut for the side pocket, adhering with liquid glue.
- 7. Run the layer of Summer Splash cardstock through the Eyelet 3D embossing folder and then lightly add some blending with a blending brush and some Summer Splash Ink. Distress and roll over the top right hand corner of this piece. Set aside.
- 8. Die cut out the largest circle from the Everyday Essentials Dies from Basic Beige and use some Basic Beige Ink and a blending brush to darken the edges of the circle. Use some vanilla baker's twine and a needle to add some hand stitching to the outer edge. Set aside.
- 9. Take about a 30cm length of the Pecan Pie Centre Stripe Ribbon and gently pull the threads apart to create a bundle of individual threads. Loop these around and place them on the Summer Splash layer using a stapler to hold them in place. Adhere the stitched circle over the top with Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere this whole piece to the card front.
- 10. Stamp a variety of images from the Country Flowers and Country Birdhouse stamp sets including a stool, two metal buckets, some foliage for the pots, a bird, some extra flowers and a selection of the individual

- small flowers. Colour these all in with a variety of Stampin' Blends and die cut with the corresponding dies. Add some Wink of Stella to images.
- 11. Use the Country Flowers Dies to also cut out some of the bunches of leaves in Lemon Lime Twist Cardstock. Use some Lemon Lime Twist and a blending brush to darken the tips of the leaves.
- 12. Adhere the stool to the stitched circle with liquid glue and then adhere the metal pot over the top. Take some of the Lemon Lime Twist leaves and place behind the bunch of flowers and then adhere the flowers and leaves over the pot with Stampin' Dimensionals. Tuck in some extra leaves and small flowers to embellish.
- 13. For the inside of the card, add an assortment of extra die cut pieces and leaves to both the inside left of the card and on the bottom of the pocket. Make sure to have nothing hanging over either side of the pocket as this will affect the mechanism from working.
- 14. Stamp two sentiments in black on some Basic Beige Cardstock. Trim these down and adhere one to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals and one to the left hand side of the inside of the card.
- 15. Take the two layers of Basic White Cardstock for the inside of the card mechanism and lightly add some Basic Beige blending to the outer edges. Spritz some Pecan Pie Stampin' Write Marker to these and then stamp some small images from the stamp set in Memento Black ink and colour with assorted Stampin' Blends. Adhere these pieces to the left hand side of the inside flap mechanisms.
- 16. Die cut out some small flowers from the dies with Summer Splash Glimmer Paper. Adhere these to both the outside and inside of the card and add some of the 2024-2026 Shimmer Gems to embellish. Spritz the card with some Wink of Stella to add some sparkle.
