
Latte Love - Circle Easel Card

Measurements

Paper	No of Pieces	Metric & Imperial Measurement
Basic White Thick Card Base	1	A4 or 8.5"x11" Cardstock Sheet score in half across the long edge.
Basic White Thick Cardstock		Scraps big enough to die cut all the Deckled Circles and to stamp/die cut the coffee cups You will need to cut two of the largest Deckled Circles and two of the 3rd largest Deckled Circles.
Basic Black		Scrap piece big enough for both of the sentiments

Instructions

- 1. Take the large sheet of Basic White Thick Cardstock (either A4 or 8.5"x 11" depending on your market) and score it at either 14.9cm or 5 ½" (in half). Once folded take the second largest Deckled Circle Die and place this on the folded edge letting one part of the circle die be off the edge of the folded score line slightly. Run this through the die cut machine so that it cuts a circle shape that opens to be a card. Using a bone folder, fold the front of the circle card back on itself and reinforce the score line. Set aside,
- 2. Cut two of the largest Deckled Circle Die and two of the third largest Deckled Circle Die from Basic White Thick cardstock. With the two largest Deckled Circle Die Cuts I have placed them together to work out exactly how they fit together (this step is optional). Once I figured this out, I added a small pencil mark to indicate where they go together on each circle.
- 3. Add adhesive to the back side of the circle card base and add this to the front side of one of the largest Deckled Circle die cuts.
- 4. Add adhesive to the front side of the folded back section of the card base, only adding it on this section. Add the second largest Deckled Circle die cuts over the top, lining it up with the base circle die aligning the pencil marks made in step two.
- 5. Take the leftover two Deckled Circle die cuts and using a Blending Brush and some Pretty in Pink ink, lightly add some blended ink around the edges of both pieces. Spritz some black ink using a Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker over both pieces.
- 6. Using the Latte Love stamps and the coffee splatter stamp, stamp some coffee splatters over the two circles in; Lemon Lime Twist, Peach Pie and Summer Splash, roughly estimating where they go pictured above. Adhere one of the smaller circles to the inside of the card with Liquid Glue. Set aside the other circle from the card front for now.
- 7. On a scrap of Basic White Thick Cardstock, stamp four coffee cup images in Memento Black. Clean the stamp and adhere to the block the wrong way placing the detailed side to the stamp block. Use this as a fill in image and add over the top of the coffee cups. Stamp in these colours; Lemon Lime Twist, Peach Ple, Lemon Lolly and Berry Burst. Use the coffee latte art images in both designs to fill in two cups of each design using Pecan Ple Ink. Die cut all these coffee cups out using the corresponding die from the Latte Love Dies.
- 8. Adhere the coffee cups to the card where shown with a mixture of Stampin' Dimensionals and Liquid Glue. Adhere one of the coffee cups to the inside of the card where shown with Stampin' Dimensionals to act as the 'stopper' for the easel. When adhering the coffee cups to the card front, if it covers up too many of the coffee splatters, stamp a few more to

- ensure they are visible. Once happy, adhere this decorated circle piece to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Cut the Peach Pie Bordered Ribbon in half lengthwise to make the width of the ribbon thinner. Tie a double bow and use your fingers to loosen some of the threads. Adhere to the card with Glue Dots where shown.
- 10. Stamp the sentiments in Versamark on some Basic Black Cardstock and heat emboss in white. Trim these images into small sentiment strips and adhere both a sentiment to the card front and one to the inside of the card.
- 11. Embellish the card by spritzing some Wink of Stella over the inside piece and the card front and embellish with some various coloured 2024-2026 In Colour Shimmer Gems.
