Measurements

Paper	No of Pieces	Metric Measurement	Imperial Measurement
Early Espresso Card Base	1	10.5cm x 29.7cm Score at 3.7cm and 7.4cm from each end	4 ¼" x 9 1/2" Score at 1" and 2" from each end
Basic Beige Puzzle Pieces	1	14.9cm x 10.5cm Cut in half at 5.25cm and then cut each at 9.9cm (see diagram)	5" x 4 ¼" Cut in half at 2 ¼" and then cut each segment at 3 ¼" (see diagram)
Early Espresso Cardstock Layers	2 2	5cm x 9.7cm 4.8cm x 5cm	3 ¼s" x 2" 2 ¼s" x 2"
Seasons of Green & Gold Paper	2	4.8cm x 9.6cm	3" x 1 7⁄8"
Gold Mercury Vellum	2	4.6cm x 4.8cm	2" x 1 7⁄8"
Basic Beige Layer for Centre	1	14.5cm x 10.1cm	5 ¼" x 4"

Instructions

1. Score the card base as stated in the measurement guide. Fold and reinforce the score lines as shown in the video so the ends of the card are accordion folded. See diagram below.



2. Cut the piece of cardstock for the puzzle pieces as shown in the following diagram from Basic Beige cardstock. Line the top of the folded card from step one at the top edge of the Paper Trimmer. Add liquid glue to each flap and line up puzzle pieces and adhere in the below pattern ensuring they line up with no overlap.



- 3. Cut the Early Espresso layers, Seasons of Green & Gold Designer Series Paper and Gold Mercury Vellum. Adhere the Gold Mercury Vellum to some Adhesive Sheet to help adhere them to Early Espresso cardstock. Adhere the Designer Paper to the Early Espresso Cardstock. Adhere these layers to the corresponding layers on the Puzzle Card.
- 4. Die cut a circle from Basic Beige using the Spotlight on Nature Dies. Lightly blend the edges with some Pecan Pie ink and spritz with some Wild Wheat. Adhere this circle where shown with some dimensionals.

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- 5. Stamp the tree from Frosted Forest in Early Espresso Ink. Use the masks to colour the trunk with some Pecan Pie Ink and then colour the tree with some Lemon Lime Twist and Granny Apple Green Ink. Finish with some Old Olive Ink with the remaining mask. Add some Wink of Stella with the final mask. Die cut tree.
- 6. Adhere this tree with some Stampin' Dimensionals where shown.
- 7. Tie a triple bow with some Linen Thread and adhere to the tree where shown with Glue Dots.
- 8. Stamp the sentiment shown with Early Espresso on some Basic Beige cardstock. Trim and add over the bow with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Stamp two small birds in Memento Ink. Colour with Wild Wheat Stampin' Blends and die cut. Adhere one to the card front where shown.
- 10. Adhere some Gold birds and some Shimmer Gems to embellish. Finish the card off with spritzing some Wink of Stella.
- Decorate the inside by lightly blending some Pecan Pie ink on a layer of Basic White. Add a strip of Designer Paper and spritz some Wild Wheat ink. Embellish with some Gold Birds the remaining stamped bird. Add onto a layer of Basic Beige and adhere to the inside of the card.
