Instructions

 Score and cut the card base using the template or video below as a guide. You will need to cut & score in this order; score at 5cm (2") from each end, then cut the two cut lines from 3.5cm (1 ¼") between scores. Finally make the scores on the centre panel and from the halfway point of the card to the cut lines.



- 2. Cut and layer all the Designer Series Paper and Copper Foil on the Crumb Cake Layers. On the 7.5cm x 4.6cm (2 ³/₄" x 1 ³/₄") piece of Crumb Cake, emboss it with the Birch 3D Embossing Folder. Add some Copper Clay Ink lightly and adhere to the larger layer of Crumb Cake. Add this to the very centre panel of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals. The Basic White panel will become the writing panel on the back of the card. Add some small stamped detail, add to the layer of Crumb Cake and adhere to the reverse of the card.
- 3. Add all the Designer Panels including the Copper Foil panels to the corresponding areas on the card. See pictures for paper designs that I have used.
- 4. Stamp two of the birds and the large branch piece on Basic White Thick Cardstock in Versamark and heat emboss in black. Die cut these images

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out along with six of the small branches in Crumb Cake. Watercolour the birds with a variety of the colours listed with a Water Painter. Add some Copper Clay Ink with a blending brush to the die cut branches. Set aside.

- 5. Die cut out the second largest circle from the Everyday Details Dies from Crumb Cake. Die cut out of the fifth smallest Deckled Circle using Copper Clay. On the Crumb Cake circle add some light Copper Clay Blending and spritz with a Copper Clay Marker. Use the Copper Clay Linen Thread to stitch through the holes in the circle. Adhere this to the back of the Copper Clay die cut circle to hide the reverse side stitching. Set aside.
- 6. Take the Garden Green for the belly band and wrap around the card. Adhere together and add some Garden Green Ink to the edges with a Blending Brush. Adhere the die cut circle to the middle of the belly band where it joins with some Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Using a stamp positioning tool, stamp the sentiments shown in Copper Clay Ink and then repeat over the top with Versamark and Clear Embossing Powder. Trim and fussy cut these out.
- 8. Add the singular bird, branches and sentiment to the circle on the belly band with Dimensionals and Glue Dots. Add a bow tied from Garden Green Linen Thread. Embellish with some Wink of Stella spritzing and some of the Earthy Tones Shimmer Gems.
- 9. On the centre panel of the card arrange the larger set of two birds, the stamped branch and the leftover Crumb Cake branches. Adhere the sentiment and a small bow tied with the Garden Green Linen Thread. Embellish the panel with some Wink of Stella.
