Instructions

- 1. Score and cut the Pool Party card base.
- 2. Fussy cut and die cut the reindeers from the Reindeer Days Designer Series Paper. I have used approximately twelve.
- 3. Using a Blending Brush and some Pool Party Ink, add some soft blending over the entire of one of the layers of Basic White. Spritz this piece with some Pretty Peacock Stampin' Write Marker.
- 4. Take the largest of the Nested Essentials Dies and place it in the centre of this piece. Lightly trace around the edges with a pencil.
- 5. Place all the reindeers (without adhering) around this layer being mindful of where the label will be die cut. You want to place any pieces well within this line and around it so you don't chop off too small of a piece (it needs to be large enough for a Mini Dimensional)
- 6. Once happy with the placement, cut a piece of Press N' Seal large enough to go over the top of this piece. Press down to adhere reindeers to the background. Trim around the edge and run through the die cut machine with the label back on top of the traced line.
- 7. Take the Press n' Seal away from the background layer and adhere Mini Dimensionals liberally over the reindeers and any pieces. Remove all the backings and line this up with the die cut framed layer. Once happy with placement you need to remove the Press N' Seal carefully and slowly. Repeat with the label.
- 8. Adhere this layer to the layer of Pretty Peacock and adhere the label back in with some dimensionals to give it some height.
- 9. Tie a triple bow with some Real Red & White Baker's Twine and adhere.
- 10. Colour some Vellum with a Dark Lemon Lime Twist Stampin' Blend and cut out two of the holly leaves. Cut the berries with Red Festive Glimmer Paper. Adhere together and place where shown.
- 11. Stamp the sentiment in Pretty Peacock Ink on a scrap piece of Basic White. Trim down and adhere to the card with some dimensionals.
- 12. Spritz the card with Wink of Stella and add some Peppermint Embellishments over the background.
- 13. To decorate the inside add some soft blending with Pool Party and Pretty Peacock ink in the bottom right hand corner. Spritz some Pretty Peacock Stampin' Write Marker and some Wink of Stella. Add one of the left over reindeers.
- 14. Stamp a sentiment in Pretty Peacock.
