



#### Measurements

Summer Splash Card Base	3	5" x 7"
Summer Splash Mechanism Piece	1	4 ¼" x 7"
Mixed Media Florals Designer Series Paper	1	5" x 7"
Basic White Thick for Centre Panel	1	5 ¾" x 3 ¾"
Basic White for Inside of Card	1	6 <sup>3</sup> /4" x 4 <sup>3</sup> /4"
Basic Black for Inside of Card	1	6 7⁄8" x 4 7⁄8"
Summer Splash Glimmer Paper for Side Strip	1	$^{3}\!$
Fluid 100 Watercolour Paper		Scrap big enough for stamping/colouring flowers & leaves
Scraps of Basic White & Summer Splash Climmer Paper		Scraps for die cutting & stamping

# Instructions

1. Cut and score the card and cut all the layers of cardstock and Designer Series Paper. For the layer of Summer Splash Cardstock that is 4 ¼" x 7" cut it & score according to the template below.



- 2. Adhere two layers of the Summer Splash cardstock and the layer of Designer Series Paper together to create a thicker 'sandwich'. Allow to dry a little bit before cutting a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" wide frame around all sides. Keep the inside.
- 3. Take the large layer of Basic White and add some soft ink blending in the right corner and add some simple stamping and colour if desired. Adhere this to the layer of Basic Black and adhere to the remaining layer of Summer Splash to create the inside of the card base.
- 4. Take the mechanism piece cut earlier and add adhesive to the larger right and left hand side flaps as shown on the diagram. Line up the centre panel with the reverse of the cut out frame piece. Once lined up, tuck the flaps with adhesive so they sit underneath the middle flap.
- 5. Once the previous step is dry. Add adhesive to the remaining small flap and add this layer on top of the Basic White/Summer Splash layer to adhere the card together. Watch the video for tips.
- Emboss the small layer of Basic White with the Plaster Painting Embossing Folder. Add some Summer Splash Ink blending around edges. Spritz with some Summer Splash Ink. Set aside.

- 7. Pull the threads out of some Summer Splash Bordered Ribbon/fray and wrap into a figure of eight loop. Die cut the detailed die with Summer Splash Glimmer Paper and use a stapler to adhere to the embossed piece. Add the frayed ribbon over the top and staple. Adhere this embossed piece to the centre panel of the card front.
- 8. Stamp the daisy, three leaves and two ladybirds from the Mixed Media Florals on some watercolour paper and heat emboss in black. Die cut out with the corresponding dies. Watercolour all these images using a Water Painter and a mixture of colours noted in the supply list. Adhere the daisies, and one of the leaf stamps to the front of the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment and heat emboss in black from the Mixed Labels set. Ink blend one half of the label with Summer Splash Ink. Add to the card front with Stampin' Dimensionals & Glue. Adhere a lady bird above this label.
- 10. Spritz the card front with some Wink of Stella. Embellish with some of the Pink Sequins.
- 11. Add the two remaining leaf images and the remaining lady bird to the reverse panel on the inside of the card and then heat emboss the extra sentiment from the Mixed Labels set in black. Trim and adhere where shown. Spritz this panel with some Wink of Stella.
