Instructions

1. Cut and score all the layers, card base and the two mechanism pieces according to the diagram below. Adhere all the layers of Designer Series Paper on the coordinating pieces of Melon Mambo. Adhere to the outer flaps, inside side flaps and middle of the inside of that card. Adhere the mechanisms to the inside of the card on top of the Designer Paper. Use the video tutorial as a guide. Adhere the two Fresh Freesia square pieces on top of the mechanism.



2. Use the following picture as a guide to stamp, die cut and punch all the stamped images, flowers, circles and stamped sentiment (this is heat embossed in white on Early Espresso)



- 3. Punch and fussy cut out all the toadstool images. Set aside.
- 4. Emboss the two Basic White squares with the Timber 3D Embossing Folder. Add some blending with Granny Apple Green Ink to these squares and adhere on top of the Fresh Freesia pop up squares.
- 5. Adhere a selection of the toadstool elements, flowers and sentiment on the two pop up squares. Adhere one of the sentiments and embellish with some sequins and Brushed Brass Butterflies. Spritz with some Wink of Stella.
- 6. Wrap the belly band around the closed card and reinforce the score lines to fold neatly. Adhere the die cut Granny Apple Green circle to either side of the Belly Band. Take some Fresh Freesia Ink and lightly blend around the smaller Basic White circle and adhere over the top of the Granny Apple Green with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Adhere the additional images including grass hill, toadstools and sentiment with some Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. Embellish with some more of the punched flowers with Sequins in the centre
- Take some of the Flirty Flamingo Baker's Twine (enough to tie a triple bow) and pull apart the threads into three. Place the threads back together and tie a triple bow for a 'fluffy' look. Adhere where shown with a Glue Dot.
- 10. Decorate the front of the belly band with some Brushed Brass Butterflies and Wink of Stella.
- 11. Take the square panel of Basic White and stamp some more grass and toadstools in the bottom right corner. Add some light blending with some Granny Apple Green and spritz with a Summer Splash Stampin' Write Marker & some Wink of Stella. Embellish with some Brushed Brass Butterflies and adhere to a larger layer of Melon Mambo. Adhere this panel to the back side of the card.
