Measurements

Instructions

- 1. Cut three large arch pieces from Blueberry Bushel, one large arch from Basic White and two large arches from the Everyday Skies Designer Paper.
- 2. Take the piece of Basic White for the mechanism and make an accordion fold style piece.
- 3. Take the Basic White Arch piece and add some Balmy Blue & Blueberry Bushel ink blending on the right hand side. Stamp some birds from the Everyday Arches stamp set in Melon Mambo and stamp the sentiment in Night of Navy. Stamp some small stars in Blueberry Bushel and spritz this piece with a Night of Navy marker. Set aside.
- 4. Adhere the two Designer Paper arches to the first two sections on the accordion fold and on the last section adhere the Basic White piece that was stamped & inked in the previous step. Flip this accordion card over and back each of these pieces with a Blueberry Bushel die cut arch.
- 5. Take the arch dies and using a piece of Basic White Cardstock, die cut out an arch with the third biggest arch die. Using the stamp that says "You are Simply Fantastic' heat emboss the sentiment in black curving around the top edge. Die cut out a 'window' for the shaker from this piece using the fifth smallest arch die. Whilst die cutting, cut out an arch from a Window sheet using the fourth biggest arch die.
- 6. Take some Balmy Blue and Blueberry Bushel Ink and a blending brush and lightly apply some ink to the frame. Flip the frame over and using Tear N' Tape or similar, adhere the Window Sheet arch to the back of this window. Apply some Foam Adhesive Strips around the edge of the window opening and the edge of the arch.
- 7. Add some of the sequin mix to the middle of the arch on the card front and then remove the Foam Tape backing and adhere the window arch over the top and seal shut. This creates the shaker card component.
- 8. Die cut some flowers from Basic White cardstock from the Happy Hibiscus dies and colour lightly with Blueberry Bushel ink using a Blending Brush. Add a rhinestone to the centre of each.
- 9. Tie a double bow with the Night of Navy Linen Thread and adhere in the bottom left corner using a Glue Dot.
- 10. Stamp the birds from the Everyday Arches stamp set in Melon Mambo on some Basic White cardstock. Fussy cut these out. Adhere the flowers and the fussy cut birds where shown on the card using Glue Dots.
- 11. Add three Hibiscus flowers/rhinestones to the middle accordion panel.
- 12. Spritz the card with some Wink of Stella.
