

Measurements

Instructions

- 1. Take your layer of Basic White for the card front and stamp the honeycomb (hexagon) image randomly over this piece in StazOn black ink. Take the swirly bee dotted line image and stamp randomly over the background in a gray coloured ink such a Basic Gray or Pebbled Path. Finally take the large text image from the Elements of Text stamp set and stamp randomly a couple of times on the edges in Crushed Curry Ink.
- 2. Using a Blending Brush, lightly blend some Lemon Lolly ink around the sides of this piece. Repeat again with some Daffodil Delight ensuring you leave the centre of this piece lighter in colour to create a vignette look.
- 3. Let this dry and then stamp some 'ink splat' images from the Elements of Text stamp in Versamark and heat emboss in gold.
- 4. Take the smallest hexagon die from the Meant to Be bundle and die cut this out of the centre (slightly towards the top) of this piece. Keep the frame and inner die cut.
- 5. Adhere the inked/stamped layer to the Basic White card base. Adhere the cut out frame back inside the negative of the hexagon cut out with glue. Take the remaining hexagon piece and adhere back into the negative space with some Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. With the second smallest hexagon die, cut this out with some Wild Wheat cardstock. Adhere this frame piece (set aside the hexagon for another project) add the Wild Wheat frame around the middle hexagon.
- 7. Create a bow with the Black & Vanilla check ribbon and tie some Linen Thread around the centre tying it into another bow. Adhere to the card where shown with a Glue Dot.
- 8. Stamp some bees, flowers & hearts in the colours shown. Die cut all of these images out including the components of the bees such the wings and antennae. Piece together the bees and add to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals, also adhering the flowers and hearts with a mixture of Glue Dots & Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Die cut out some of the tiny flowers from the Meant to Bee dies in Summer Splash Glimmer Paper. Adhere to the card where shown,
- 10. Stamp the sentiment in Versamark and heat emboss in black. Fussy cut the sentiment and adhere where shown.
- 11. Embellish the card front with some Dots for Days adding them to some of the flowers centres and spritz with some Wink of Stella.
- 12. Embellish the inside of the card as shown below with some light ink blending with Pool Party and extra left over die cut images. I have added a sentiment from the matching Bee My Valentine stamp set.
